### **METHODOLOGY**



When was the opinion poll conducted?	23 <sup>rd</sup> – 27 <sup>th</sup> May, 2022
How was the opinion poll conducted?	Interviews were conducted through Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews (CATI)
Universe and Survey sample	The relevant section of the public that was targeted in the poll (i.e. the universe) was persons who were voters, I 8 years old and above at the time of the poll. The overall poll had a target survey sample size of 9000 respondents.
What was the margin of error?	±1.033% at 95% degree of confidence.
What was the response rate?	96% response rate.
Weighting	When the achieved interviews slightly differ from the designed demographics, post- stratification weights are applied to the dataset to correct the demographics and ensure they are representative of the target population.
Survey Geographical Coverage	The poll covered 47 counties in nine sub-regions of Kenya. To ensure the survey findings were representative of Kenyan voters, 18+ years population, the distribution of the survey sample across the 47 counties was proportionately allocated.
Data Analysis	Data was processed and analyzed using SPSS 26 statistical software due to it's high accuracy and reliability.
Voter statistics	The voter numbers have been derived from the interim/non-audited IEBC latest voter registration figures. To determine absolute voter popularity figures the base of 22.2m was applied in its entirety.






