## **METHODOLOGY**



When was the opinion poll conducted?	2 <sup>nd</sup> – 3 <sup>rd</sup> July, 2022		
How was the opinion poll conducted?	Interviews were conducted through Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews (CATI)		
Universe and Survey sample	The relevant section of the public that was targeted in the survey (i.e. the universe) was persons who were 18 years old and above across the 17 constituencies in Nairobi. The target sample was 1024 Kenyan adults.		
What was the margin of error?	±3% at 95% degree of confidence.		
What was the response rate?	96% response rate.		
Weighting	When the achieved interviews slightly differ from the designed demographics, post-stratification weights are applied to the dataset to correct the demographics and ensure they are representative of the target population.		
Survey Geographical Coverage	The poll covered 17 constituencies & 85 wards of Nairobi County. To ensure the survey findings were representative of Kenyan voters, 18+ years population, the distribution of the survey sample across the 17 constituencies was proportionately allocated.		
Data Analysis	Data was processed and analyzed using SPSS 26 statistical software due to it's high accuracy and reliability.








#### WHY IS THE COUNTRY HEADED IN THE RIGHT/WRONG DIRECTION?






#### WHY RIGHT DIRECTION






